An Examination of Conscience Regarding the Mass

When I enter the parking lot when arriving for Mass, do I drive in through the entrance driveway or an exit only driveway?

Do I park in a designated parking space? Do I park in a driving lane? Do I park in No Parking zone? Do I park in a Fire Lane?

Do I habitually arrive for Mass late? Why? What can I do to change this and make sure I arrive at least 5 minutes early?

Do I habitually leave Mass early? Why? What can I do to change this so that I may remain for the Final Blessing?

Do I use the restroom before leaving home and/or before Mass so that I do not need to get up during the Mass unless absolutely necessary?

Do I observe the Eucharistic Fast by having no food nor drink 1 hour prior to receiving Holy Communion?

Do I dress respectfully and appropriately for the Mass, much as I would if meeting a dignitary?

Do I silence my phone prior to Mass?

Do I dispose of gum prior to entering the Church?

Do I dispose of coffee cups and water bottles prior to entering the Church?

While in the Sacred Worship Space, do I speak in a whisper and only when necessary?

Am I teaching my children the appropriate behavior while in Church?
