The Christmas Giving Tree resulted in approximately 590 gifts being distributed to various agencies.

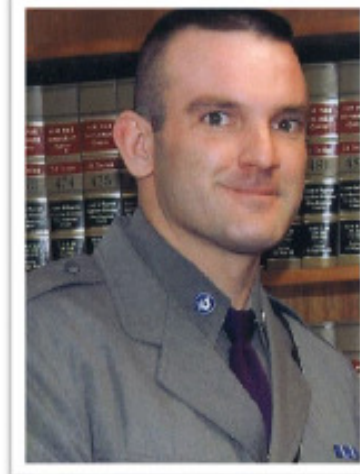
St. Peter’s Kitchen volunteers continue to work at the Kitchen the 4th and 5th Thursday of every month.
