Over the last three weeks, our young people have been celebrating their First Penance. I have to say how impressed I am with how devoutly and how seriously the children are in their First Confession. That is a testament not only to them, but to their parents and family, their catechists, and this parish. They are an example to all of us, demonstrating the importance of this sacrament. Coming up next Saturday morning and the following Saturday morning, we will celebrate First Holy Communion. Once again, I am so impressed with our First Communicants and I hope you'll join with me in praying for their families and, especially for them, as they celebrate this milestone in their Sacramental life.

I want to thank all of the volunteers who have stepped forward to be ushers and altar servers. The forms are still in the foyer of the Church and I encourage you to consider volunteering for these ministries. The vitality of a parish is marked, in part, by the parishioners willing to come forward and support the parish with their time. Please consider being an usher. And parents - please encourage your children (grades 3 and up) to be altar servers and serve God at His holy altar.

Our CMA is doing well. We've reached 85% of our goal. Thank you! We have one month left to make the remaining 15%. We can do this! I am sure that you will join with me in supporting the ministries of the diocese to the poor, the migrant, the student, the family in need. If you can help us reach our goal, that would be great!

Lastly, I want to thank Father Matthew Temple for his assistance at St. Lawrence. Father has been assisting here for as long as I have been here and has been be-

come a great part of our community. I know we enjoy his presence and his inspiring homilies. I also want to thank Father Bob Ring for helping out when I am in need. As you know, I am the only assigned priest here. At times, I do need help and am grateful for my brother priests who step in.

With that said, I want to ask two things of you. First, please understand that there will be times every now and then that due to unexpected circumstances, Saturday confessions will need to be cancelled. I will always post a sign on the confessional door. I think in my near 11 years here - we have had to cancel confessions twice (the latest being last Saturday). Sometimes, it just can't be helped. Our neighboring parishes of St. John's on the Ridge, St. Mark's, Our Mother of Sorrows, St. Leo's in Hilton and St. John's in Spencerport all offer confessions about the same time as we do and you would be welcome in any of those parishes as their parishioners are welcome here.

Lastly, please understand that if you call requesting the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick - I may not be able to get to you immediately. I will come but may have to delay my arrival. Again, I beg you, do not wait until your loved one is at their last moments to call me. It is best if you can call me for this Sacrament when you or your loved one goes into the hospital, is diagnosed with a terminal disease, etc. This is an important Sacrament and we shouldn't wait to receive it. This weekend, like all fourth weekends of the month, I will offer this Sacrament after all the Masses. This is the same Sacrament we receive if asking for the "Last Rites." Thank you.




