For the next two weeks, I will be taking some R and R. Fr. Temple will take care of the weekend Masses for us. I am very grateful for his assistance. For this coming week, there will be neither a Communion Service nor a Mass on Monday, October 9 or Friday, October 13. We will have a Communion Services on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday at 8:30 a.m. The following week, we will have Communion Services from Monday, October 16 to Thursday October 19 at 8:30. There will not be a Mass or Communion Service on Friday October 20.

If a funeral should happen to be needed during the next two weeks, please have the funeral director call the rectory. We will contact some area priests to see when they can celebrate them for us. Please do not schedule any funeral on your own without talking to us.

For any emergency needs requiring the Sacrament of the Sick, please call the rectory. We will do our best to find a priest. If It is not an emergency, we will wait until after I return to do those.

We have completed the instillation of our new security alarm system in the Church. Our fire alarm system is directly connected to the fire department now (the old one was not!). If any alarm goes off in the church, please leave the church at once. Do not even wait for any instructions. Just leave!

Your safety and the safety of our whole parish is one of my top priorities. To that end, we are now in the process of installing a new and much more efficient and updated fire and security system in the school building. To that end, Debbie Cichelli has moved into a shared office space with Donna Gray in the school building and our main office of the school is now located in the space that was the Faith Formation office. This is one way that we are trying to control who has access to the school building.

If you have any need to come to the school building during school hours, it is best to call first and to make an appointment. We simply cannot allow anyone to just drop in at any time. If you need to come to the building, please follow all instructions. During school hours, the school building should be considered off limits to all except approved persons.

Lastly, a few weeks ago, someone or someones came to the rectory front door at about 3 a.m. and screamed, shouted, continually rang the door bell and banged on the door. I did contact the police who came and investigated. We believe it was some teens playing some kind of prank. Please know that if you need me when the office is closed, call the office and leave a message on my extension—x.207. Unless I know you're coming, I will not be answering the rectory door for my own safety.

#### **Pastoral Planning Task Force Update**

The Charlotte/Greece/Hilton Pastoral Planning Task Force met again on August 29. The bulk of the meeting was devoted to preparing for the priesthood of the future when pastoral leaders will likely be responsible for an increased number of parish communities. We want to consider ways to keep the mission of our parishes at the center while trying to relieve our Pastors/Pastoral Administrators of some responsibilities. To help lay members of the Task Force have a better sense of what leaders actually do, each pastoral leader was asked to share some of his actions on a typical weekday. Task force members learned some of the ways that a bridge has been built between Holy Cross and Our Mother of Sorrows. Finally, Karen Rinefierd, who facilitates the work of the Task Force, shared what has been learned from leaders, staff, and parishioners across the diocese about healthy practices in clustering parishes. In October the Task Force will continue its work to draft possible parish groupings to present to parishioners for input as preparation for the time when the Bishop is not able to fill an opening for a Pastor/Pastoral Administrator.
