The First Confessions were heard at Mother of Sorrows Church Saturday morning. And, now that we are in Advent, I want to give a special reminder that we hear confessions every Saturday beginning at 3 p.m.

Weddings

here at St. Lawrence Church. When a couple is engaged, they should call us FIRST to begin the scheduling process. Do not schedule your reception venue, your photographer, tell people to purchase airline tickets. We have to determine if you are free to be married in the Catholic Church and we must do some preliminary paper work. Prior marriages, whether Catholic nor not, can be an impediment to marrying in the Catholic Church. Either the bride or the groom should contact us by phone. While the mothers of the brides or grooms always want to be helpful, we need to speak directly to the bride and groom. There are two options for the marriage: a Nuptial Mass and a Nuptial Ceremony. The ceremony is the Liturgy of the Word with the Marriage Rite. It is fully Catholic and sacramental. It should not be thought of as a punishment of any kind. If either the bride or the groom is not Catholic, if the Eucharist is not a regular part of the bride and/or groom's life, if a large portion of the invited guests are not actively (weekly) worshiping Catholics - the Nuptial Ceremony is the more appropriate choice. We will discuss this with the engaged couple.

Funerals

As of this writing, we have celebrated 65 funerals this calendar year at St. Lawrence Church, more than one per week. Sometimes, we are celebrating 5 or even 6 funerals in one week. When your loved one dies, please contact the Funeral Director and give them at least 3 possible days that the funeral could take place. They will contact us and we will work it out. Sometimes, the first choice you have is not available for the Church or the Funeral Director. Also, it is much better if you work with a Funeral Director. The Church cannot provide the services a Funeral Director can. And, please note that "eulogies" are not allowed at the Catholic Mass of Burial. "Words of Remembrance of Faith" are allowed but we prefer they be given at the calling hours, or the cemetery, or the family gathering after the Mass. If given at Mass, they must be written out and pre-approved by me, the pastor, at least 24 hours prior to the Mass. It should never be assumed that the words will be allowed. Speeches containing inappropriate remarks, off color jokes, and no mention of the deceased's faith should not be given at the Mass but elsewhere.
