The Second Sunday of Advent brings to me a sense of deep gratitude for you, the parishioners I am blessed to serve. Your commitment to the parish, your flexibility to keep up with the many changes in the Church and the ever challenging pastoral landscape, your sense of humor and your own sense of gratitude humble me. And what amazes me is your generosity.

As of this writing, we have reached about 55% of our CMA goal of \$163,000 from 289 donors. That is, in one word, incredible! I have every confidence that we can make our goal this year *before* Easter. In my time here at St. Lawrence, now 11 years, we've never done that.

This past summer, I had the opportunity to sit down and meet with about 10 parishioners who have been very supportive of the CMA in years past. They are a leadership group. In each meeting, I was so impressed by their suggestions, their input, their willingness to give whatever they could to St. Lawrence. This leadership group, every one of them, increased their CMA giving from last year and raised nearly \$15,000.00 themselves. That was even before any letters were sent out or any mention of the CMA in this bulletin.

What is the CMA? It is the Catholic Ministries Appeal of the Diocese of Rochester. The monies raised help to support Bishop Matano and the diocesan ministries for which he is responsible. The CMA supports our seminarians studying for the priesthood and, God willing, will be a part of the next generation of priests to lead our parishes in the future. The CMA supports our Catholic Schools. As a pastor of a Catholic School, I know the impact Catholic education has on our community. The CMA supports our parish staff members in their day to day work.

The CMA supports so much!

If you have your letter at home, would you consider a donation? If you have never donated before, why not participate this year! Shock me! Let's make our goal not by Easter, but by Christmas!

Next week, I'll have CMA envelopes in the pews for your convenience. And thank you for your donations. Every year, when we don't make our goal, we have to take some money from our holdings and pay the unmet goal difference to the diocese. Let's not do this this year. Let's go over our goal. If we do—half of that overage comes back to us. Thank you again from a very grateful pastor.



Pastoral Planning Task Force Update

The Charlotte/Greece/Hilton Pastoral Planning Task Force met on November 8. This meeting was devoted to discussing the report created by a subcommittee of the best parish groupings if our 7 parishes had only 5, 4, 3, or 2 leaders (Pastors/Pastoral Administrators). The subcommittee was praised for their fine work. They were asked to meet again to create multiple options for the time when the number of current leaders decreases, since it is unknown which of our leaders would be the first to leave due to being transferred, entering senior status (retirement), or other potential causes. We recognize that any implementation of these proposals would be at the discretion of the Bishop of Rochester. The task force will discuss the next draft report at its January meeting. Parish staff members will be gathered to give their input in February followed by pastoral and finance councils and then parishioners at large.
