Over the last two years, representatives and the pastors/pastoral leaders of the seven parishes in Greece/ Charlotte/Hilton have been meeting in a task force. The mission of this task force is quite simple: to discuss and come up with multiple options for the seven parishes for the future, to give those options in writing to the bishop of the diocese as he moves forward with pastoral assignments. Our driving force and foundation of our discussions are the following realities: the number of available and active diocesan priests is growing smaller and not larger; the number of active and worshipping Catholics is growing smaller and not larger; the available resources, both financial resources and human resources, is growing smaller and not larger; and the infrastructure of the seven parishes is aging and demanding.

In light of this, the discussion is centered on a key question: how do we best meet the needs of the Catholic community of Greece/Charlotte/Hilton as we move forward into the future?

As we've reported before, some of what needs to be done has already happened. Our Faith Formation ministry and some of our Sacramental Preparation Ministry is now shared amongst St. Lawrence, St. Charles Borromeo, Mother of Sorrows, and Holy Cross. Our Youth Ministry is shared between St. Charles Borrromeo and St. Lawrence. I certainly can see easily the day that Confirmation preparation, marriage preparation, baptismal preparation, RCIA, and CYO are shared.

Our Finance office is shared with St. Leo's, St. Mark's, St. John's Spencerport, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Hamlin, Nativity parish in Brockport, and St. Marianne Cope in Henrietta. I can foresee the day when that list grows larger.

In the midst of change, our faith remains strong.

Please note the four page handout given in church last week and this week regarding all the spiritual opportunities amongst our seven parishes for Lenten prayer, activity, and growth. This is very good and very positive.

I pray that we all begin thinking of ourselves as Catholics. The word means "universal." We are not just parishioners at this or that parish. We are Roman Catholics and belong to one Catholic church. We are not competing with neighboring parishes. We are joining with them in our faith efforts. As time goes on, we'll hear more about the work of the Task Force. Pray for its continued success.
