Saint Joseph's Table

On **Saturday, March 23rd, at about 5 p.m.** right after the 4 p.m. Mass—we will celebrate the tradition of the Saint Joseph's Table. This is an old Italian tradition. What is it? In Italy, whose patron saint is Saint Joseph, the people of the neighborhoods and villages would gather on the feast day of Saint Joseph, March 19, for a simple meal. As it is during the Season of Lent, the meal would be meatless.

Every household would bring a dish prepared to share with ten or fifteen other people. There would always be more than enough. So the leftovers would be given to the poor so that they might eat.

This year, at Saint Lawrence, we return to this simple and beautiful tradition. If you wish to join us, please see page 5 for how you can reserve a place and to let us know which meatless dish to pass you will bring for 10-12 people. Unlike in years past, we will not sell tickets either before the event nor at the door. Your price of admission is not money but food!

And, if you are bringing more than 12 people, please make sure your dish is equal to the number of people in your party. For example, if you're bringing 20 people—you need to bring a dish to pass for 20.

We gather not just because we want to eat a dinner. If you want to pay for a dinner—there are many restaurants in our area. We gather as faithful Catholics led by our faith to eat simply, to give food to the hungry.

Our leftovers will go to St. Joseph's House of Hospitality in the city to help feed the poor.

I hope you will join us.




Next weekend our parish will join with Catholic parishes across the Diocese and country to take up the annual Catholic Relief Services collection.
